Pastor's Pen

One word defines my time here at Franklin Presbyterian Church. BOLD.

When I interviewed with the Pastor Nominating Committee (PNC) in the spring of 2020, I was introduced to an idea called The Bold Approach. In my profile, I noted that I strove to Boldly Love God and Boldly Love My Neighbor. Seeing a confluence of Boldness led to my calling here.




